EPP Process

- Our Area Incharge visit various schools and colleges of different villages and cities.
- Recommendations are taken from Schools, neighbours, peers etc.
- Those found to be in need fill in the EPP application form
- Our Youth Counsellor (YC) visit's the childs family and performs initial checks
- Each applicant is given an EPP number for reference.
- Background checks are carried out from the head office.
- Applicants who pass all checks are put on our database for sponsorship.
- After a child is selected by the Sangat, they are enrolled in scholarship program.
- From this point forth, the childs attendance and reports are monitored This ensures
 - -Money is spent only on Education
 - -Updates can be provided to the Sangat member who is sponsoring the child

We encourage each sponsor to form a bond with the child they select. Donations are only part of the picture, your time and devotion is what will have the bigger impact on the childs upbringing. Our best performing students are the ones who are monitored by their sponsors, each mentored child has a sense of accountability increasing their drive to further their studies

To promote this healthy relationship, we provide each sponsor with:

- A welcome pack containing a photo and information about the selected child
- Annual progres reports on the childs education
- A personal invitiation to visit the child in India
- Celebrate the childs milestone victories in annual prize giving events

Suchajji Foundation

'Guru Nanak Dev Ji Institute of Suchajji Foundation'. This project is meant for providing free quality education to needy students who cannot afford an education. Suchajji is a word from Gurbani which means: A person full of good thoughts and qualities. The ambition is to prepare well Educated Gursikhs for higher posts. Besides preparing Academically strong pupil, EPP will try to do its best to also teach them Gurbani, Harmonium, Tabla, Lecturing skills and Katha skills to make Spiritually strong individuals too.



Currently 250 students are studying at no cost to them. The School has good infrastructure with AC and Smart classrooms. This creates a comfortable and professional environment for them to work in. The school also offers extra curricular activities to encourage Arts, Sports and Music.
